INTRODUCTION

Dearest reader, this was one of the hardest book for me to write, because it was the most painful. The problem was the knowledge that came to me of this so-called third wave group of Christians called Pentecostals / Evangelicals Fundamentalists and their involvement in the horrors of the Israeli-Palestinian conflict. I was able to dig out solid information revealing that Evangelicals are in a large way **responsible** for the extreme, biased pro-Israeli foreign policy of the U. S. government that has caused the Jews to escape investigation and prosecution for many war crimes and horrific human rights violations against the Palestinian people, whose land they took by force of violence and now occupy.

They are thus responsible also for the many horrible deaths that have occurred on both sides, but especially that of the defenseless Palestinians whom they despise as do the Israelis.

This booklet has given evidence of the Evangelicals support of Jewish terrorists with money and psychological help, and also encouraging the Israeli government to break their legal agreements with the Palestinians and to flout international law. Evidence is presented to show that both the Zionism that was responsible for the setting up of the State of Israel, and Evangelicalism, were founded on **Spiritualism**, hence both support **terrorism**. All this is done by Evangelicals because they believe **gross false doctrines** that deny that Jesus is indeed the Messiah and exalt the Jewish race to the pinnacle of glory, while the Bible stresses that they remain under YHWH's curse because of the rejection and crucifixion of Jesus the Messiah.

THE EVANGELICALS' DEVILISH INVOLVEMENT IN THE ISRAELI– PALESTINIAN CONFLICT

1. Revolutionary terrorism such as the French Revolution of 1789 originated in Spiritualism or spiritualistic religions.

"The revolutionary faith was shaped not so much by the critical rationalism of the French Enlightenment (as is generally believed) as by the occultism and proto-romanticism of Germany. This faith was incubated in France during the revolutionary era within a small sub-culture of literary intellectuals who were immersed in journalism, fascinated by secret societies, and subsequently infatuated with "ideologies" as a secular surrogate for religious belief." James H. Billington, **Fire in the Minds of Men**, pp. 3-4.

2. In tracing the "origins of revolutionary faith" we are told that the sources go right back to Masonic and occult groups, showing that **Spiritualism** was in fact the real source of revolutionary terrorism.

"The flame of faith had begun its migrations a century earlier, when some European aristocrats transferred their lighted candles from Christian altars to Masonic lodges. The flame of occult alchemists, which had promised to turn dross into gold, reappeared at the center of new "circles" seeking to recreate a golden age: Bavarian Illuminists conspiring against the Jesuits …" **Ibid**, pp. 5-6.

"In search of primal, natural truths, revolutionaries looked back to pre-Christian antiquityadopting pagan names like "Anaxagoras" Chaumette and "Anarcharsis" Cloots, idealizing above all the semi-mythic Pythagoras as the model intellect-turned-revolutionary and the Pythagorean belief in prime numbers, geometric forms, and the higher harmonies of music." **Ibid**, p. 6.

"In announcing the need to complete the "physical" revolution with a revolution in the moral order, Robespierre had proclaimed the universal religion of Nature." **Ibid**, p. 49

3. Again, we see the fact that all Communistic or revolutionary values and practice can be traced to Spiritualism which is the workings of Satanism.

"Marxism has governed over one-third of mankind. If it could be shown that the originators and perpetrators of this movement were indeed behind-closed doors devil-worshippers, consciously exploiting satanic powers, would not such a startling realization require action? ... Would Marxism be discredited if men knew about his connection with Satanism?" Richard Wurmbrand, **Marx and Satan**, pp. vii, viii.

"But Marx and his entourage thought alike. Lunatcharski, a leading philosopher who was once minister of education of the U. S. S. R., wrote in **Socialism and Religion** that Marx set aside all contact with God and instead put Satan in front of marching proletarian columns." **Ibid**, p. 29.

"More about the relationship between Marxism and the occult can be found in **Psychic Discoveries Behind the Iron Curtain** by Sheila Ostrander and Lynn Schroder. It is highly significant that the Communist East had been much more advanced than the West in research about the dark forces manipulated by Satan." **Ibid**, p. 79.

4. It is **Spiritualism** in its exaltation of Lucifer as God and all the daring blasphemies that goes with this that can be seen as the philosophical source of **revolution** and all forms or **terrorism**.

"The Marxist philosopher Ernst Bloch writes in his book **Atheism in Christianity** that ... the seduction of the first human couple by the serpent opens the way of salvation for mankind. So man starts to become a god; it is the way of rebellion. Priestcraft and the possessors of goods repressed this truth. The original sin consists in the fact that man does not wish to be like God. Man must conquer the power. The theology of revolution wills it that man should conquer the power of God. The world must be changed in the image of man. There should be no heaven at all. The belief in a personal God is the fall into sin. This fall must be repaired." **Ibid**, p. 121.

5. Even Zionist terrorism practiced against Palestinians by the State of Israel today is rooted in Spiritualism, because Zionism was originated out of the spiritualism of Talmudism and Kabbalism. Concerning the origins of Zionism, we are told that it was the Jewish attempt to retake Palestine by Jewish efforts without the aid of the so-called Messiah.

"Jacob Katz writes that Zionism was "Jewish messianic belief ... purged of its miraculous elements, and retaining its political, social and some of its spiritual aspects." Some of the important ideas of Jewish secular nationalism were first formulated by men from the tradition or religious millenarianism. In 1834, in the booklet **Hear O Israel**, Yehudah Alkalai (1798-1878), a preacher of a small Separdi community in Semlin near Belgrade, argued that the establishment of Jewish colonies in the Holy Land was a necessary preparation for the Redemption. The traditional view is that the settlement of the land will follow the miraculous coming of the messiah, but Alkali wrote that the Redemption would begin with the efforts of the Jews in settling the land, and he supported his arguments with reference to the notion of the Messiah ben Joseph, who would conquer the Holy Land prior to the coming of the Messiah ben David." Stephen Sharot, **Messianism, Mysticism and Magic**, p. 218.

"In a letter to a member of the Rothschild family in 1836, Kalischer wrote: "The beginning of the Redemption will come through natural causes by human effort and by the will of the governments to gather the scattered of Israel into the Holy Land." Kalischer gave greater consideration to these ideas in his later years, and in his book **Seeking Zion** (1862) he wrote that the Redemption would not occur as a sudden miracle but would begin when influential Jews gained the consent of the nations for the Jewish settlement of the Holy Land ... The Jews could save themselves only by reviving the nation and returning to the fatherland." **Ibid**, pp. 218,219.

6. So wrong was Zionism that we are told it was socialistic, which we saw started from Spiritualism.

"Syrkin distinguished between "rabbinic Judaism," which he argued held the people in chains, and "prophetic Judaism," which incorporated the socialist vision and positive national elements. He saw Zionist Socialism as the full materialization or prophetic values, and he expressed those values in the symbols of the messiah, the last days, and the Redemption. He announced that the hope for a messiah, always the basic sentiment of the **Galut** Jew, will be converted into political fact." **Ibid**, p. 219.

7. Evangelicalism and Pentecostalism did not start with the rediscovery of any truth at all, it started in spiritualistic manifestations or "Christian" Spiritualism.

"End time restorationism had its genesis in the early morning hours of the first day of the twentieth century. A twenty-seven-year old preacher from Topeka, Kansas, named Charles Parham placed his hands on the head of his young student, Agnes Ozman. Suddenly, a "halo seemed to surround her head and face" and Agnes began to speak Chinese. For three solid days she was utterly incapable of speaking a single word in English. Even more incredibly, when she tried to write, only Chinese characters emerge from her pen." Hank Hanegraaff, **Counterfeit Revivals**, p. 125.

8. Further proof of the spiritualism roots of Evangelicalism can be seen in the so-called Azusa Street "revivals."

"The end time restoration of Pentecostal power proved to be so compelling that Christians and cultists alike suspended their meetings and headed to 312 Azusa Street. Together they engaged in the "jerks" and in "treeing the devil." It wasn't long before "spiritualists and mediums from the numerous occult societies of Los Angeles began to attend and to contribute their séances and trances to the service." In time things got so out of hand that "Seymour wrote Parham for advice on how to handle 'the spirits' and begged him to come to Los Angeles to take over supervision of the revival." When Parham arrived, he was outraged at the spiritual pandemonium he encountered. He forcefully denounced the "hypnotists and spiritualists who seemed to have taken over the services." While Seymour was sympathetic to Parham's concerns, he refused correction, and the two pillars of Pentecostalism suffered an irreparable falling out. Seymour barred Parham from ever preaching at Azusa Street again. Parham, in turn, denounced Seymour as possessed." **Ibid**, pp. 127-128.

9. Here again is more evidence that Evangelicalism / Pentecostalism is riddled in Spiritualism. "Here, obviously, a wrong spirit is operating. In certain meetings the people are actually 'pulled away' or fall backwards on the floor unconscious, even against their will ... Nowhere in the Book of Acts do we read of the apostles needing helpers to catch the people who had fallen backwards. Today this is happening more and more in certain assemblies and is very clearly a sign of strong influences on the part of the powers of darkness causing the phenomenon known as 'slain in the spirit.' A typical example may illustrate these statements. Barratt, who brought the 'Pentecostal Revival' from Los Angeles to Europe, in his own words describes his experience of the Baptism with the Spirit on November 5, 1906 as follows: The power came so suddenly and powerfully that I lay on the floor speaking in tongues incessantly for some time ... It seemed as if an iron hand laid over my jaws. Both jaws and tongue were worked by this unseen power." Alexander Seibel, **The Church Infiltrated**, pp. 41-42.

"One young man lay on the ground for hours earnestly pleading for tongues. In another instance the subject had been urged by charismatic tutors to keep repeating the word 'Hallelujah' until he could break out in tongues. In both cases the subjects did acquire the coveted ability. Later testing, however, revealed that in each case a demon had entered the victim and had imparted the glossolalia ..." Gerald Mc Graw, Quoted in **Ibid**, p. 78.

"The Charismatic movement appears to be on the whole and emanation of the world-wide wave of the irrational, the occult and the mysticism upon the life of the Church." P. A. Dubois, quoted in **Ibid**, p. 209.

10. As with other fanatical spiritualistically directed movements, Evangelicals have been terribly involved in the Zionist State of Israel. So deep has been their involvement and so horrible, that Evangelicals can truly be considered a terrorist group supporting the terrorism of the Israeli State against Muslims. Evangelicals were plotting acts of terrorism against Muslims in Israel.

"In early 1999, members of a Denver, Colorado dispensationalist group called Concerned Christians were arrested by Israeli police, handcuffed, jailed as common criminals and deported back to the States. Israeli police accused them of planning a "bloody apocalypse" to hasten the Second Coming of Christ. It was suggested that they plotted the destruction of Jerusalem's most holy Islamic shrine. In a fervent wish to replace the mosque with a Jewish temple, the Denver cult members are no different from other dispensationalists who believe God wants this done." Grace Halsell, **Forcing God's Hand**, p. 63.

11. This proves that Evangelicalism is not genuine Christianity, but is Spiritualism with a Christian guise. Just the idea of supporting a State and a people represented by the hexagram on the Israeli flag, a symbol that means all the spiritualistic evils that God hates, is proof that Evangelicals are not of God, but is spiritualism, which is also the philosophical roots of Zionism. Observe the support for the State of Israel to the point of lawlessness. Can God be pleased with this? No, not at all.

"'No, it is related to our era,' Owen says. 'The Bible tells us that in the End Times the Jews will have renewed their animal sacrifice.' In other words, I repeat, a temple must be built so that the Jews can resume their animal sacrifice? 'Yes,' said Owen quoting Ezekiel 44:29 to prove his point. Is Owen convinced that Jews, aided by Christians, should destroy the mosque, build a temple and reinstate the killing of animals in the temple—all in order to please God? 'Yes,' he replies. 'That's the way it has to be. It's in the Bible." **Ibid**, p. 65.

12. Of course that is not in the Bible. Now, even some Evangelicals identify the six-pointed star or the hexagram called Magan David as a cursed object that curses others and should

be regarded as demonic thereby requiring such demons to be cast out. Read:

"CURSING OTHERS AND BEING CURSED-Call out the demons that come in through the curses also ... Hexagram, Star of David, Magan David, Cabbalistic Magic Symbol ..." **End-Time Deliverance Center Demon Buster, Moody Deliverance Manual**, (Lists of Demons to Cast Out in the Name of Jesus), pp. 9,10.

13. Yet Evangelicals can be found in the murky world of terrorist intrigue. They have rubbed shoulders with a Mr. Goldfoot, the Jew that blew up portions of the Jerusalem's King David Hotel in July 22, 1946. They knew he was a terrorist and that he was planning acts of terrorism again. They all have a connection with Ariel Sharon who is described as a war-criminal.

"Reisenhoover-short, rotund, balding and a Born Again Christian blessed with a fine tenor voice-told me he frequently was invited during the Regan administration to White House gatherings of dispensationalists, where he was a featured soloist. Reisenhoover spoke freely to me of his plans to move tax-free dollars from American donors to Israel. In 1985 he served as chairman of the American Forum for Jewish Christian Cooperation, being assisted by Douglas Krieger as executive director, and an American rabbi, David Ben Ami, closely linked with Ariel Sharon. Additionally, Reisenhoover served as chairman of the board for the Jerusalem Temple Foundation, which has as its sole purpose the rebuilding of a temple on the site of the present Muslim shrine. Reisenhoover chose as the foundation's international secretary Stanley Goldfoot. Goldfoot emigrated in the 1930s from South Africa to Palestine and became a member of the notorious Stern gang, which shocked the world with its massacres of Arab men, women and children. Such figures as David Ben-Gurion denounced the gang as Nazis and outlawed them. Goldfoot, according to the Israeli newspaper Davar, placed a bomb on July 22, 1946, in Jerusalem's King David Hotel that destroyed a wing of the hotel housing the British Mandate secretariat and part of the military headquarters. The operation killed some 100 British and other officials and, as the Jewish militants planned, hastened the day the British left Palestine. "He' a very solid, legitimate terrorist," Reisenhoover said admiringly of Goldfoot. "He has the qualifications for clearing a site for the temple." Reisenhoover also said that while Christian militants are acting on religious fervor, their cohort Goldfoot does not believe in God or sacred aspects of the Old Testament. For Goldfoot, it's a matter of Israeli control over all of Palestine." Grace Halsell, Forcing God's Hand, pp. 67-68.

14. Evangelicals are so far from God, they are so much **not God's people** that they allowed this Jewish terrorist to speak in their churches soliciting money to rebuild a Jewish temple which is the very denial of the Messiahship of Jesus Christ whom these Evangelicals profess to believe in.

"Reisenhoover told me he had sponsored Goldfoot on several trips to the United States, where Goldfoot spoke on religious radio and TV stations and to church congregations. Reisenhoover helped me secure a tape cassette of a talk Goldfoot made in Chuck Smith's Calvary Chapel in Costa Mesa, California. In soliciting donations for a temple, Goldfoot did not tell the Christians about plans to destroy the mosque ... Might he, I asked, after we

had visited casually over coffee, help me arrange an interview with Goldfoot? "Oh, no," Giacumakis responded, dropping his head into both hands, as one does on hearing a disaster. "You don't want to meet him. He goes back to the Irgun terrorist group!" Raising his head and waving an arm toward the King David Hotel, he added, "Stanley Goldfoot was in charge of that operation. He will not stop at anything. His idea is to rebuild the temple, and if that means violence, then he will not hesitate to use violence." Giacumakis paused, then assured me that while he himself did not believe in violence, "If they do destroy the mosque and the temple is there, that does mean I will not support it."" Ibid, p. 68.

15. Another so-called Evangelical Christian by the name of reverend James E. Deloach said that Evangelicals gave money to the Jewish mass murderer Mr. Goldfoot to aid in the release to Jewish terrorists. All this shows that Evangelicals have a very destructive role in the Middle-East crisis.

""I know Stanley very, very well. We're good friends," he said. "He is a very strong person." Of Reisenhoover, Deloach said, "He's very talented—at raising money. He's raising \$100 million. A lot of this has gone to paying lawyers who gained freedom for 29 Israelis who attempted to destroy the mosque. It cost us quite a lot of money to get their freedom." And how, I ask, did he and the others funnel the money from U. S. donors to the aid of the Jewish terrorists? "We've provided support for the Ateret Cohanim Yeshiva." The Jewish school, I asked, that prepares students to make animal sacrifice? "Yes," he agreed. And Christian donors are paying for that? "It takes a lot of training," he said. Then, quite proudly: "I've just hosted in my Houston home two fine young Israelis who study how to do the animal sacrifice in the temple to be built." Pastor De Loach talked for more than one hour, all of which he permitted me [the author] to record." **Ibid**, pp. 67-70.

16. Destroying the Muslim's shrine and perhaps even starting World War III was God's will according to this apostate Evangelical.

"Before he left my apartment, I asked one final question: what if the Jewish terrorists he supports are successful and they destroy the Dome of the Rock and Al Aqsa—shrines holy to every fifth person in the world today—and this triggers World War III and a nuclear holocaust? Would he and Reisenhover not be responsible? "No," he said—because what they are doing is "God's will."" **Ibid**, p. 70.

17. Imagine, Evangelicals are considered as militaristic.

"In becoming more conservative, the American Jews recognized that the Israeli Right and the Christian Right were nationalistic and militaristic, each with a doctrine centered around Israel and a cult of Land." **Ibid**, p. 83.

18. Jews have been called upon to support the Evangelicals and not because they believe in Jesus, no, not at all.

"In the case of Jerry Falwell, liberal Jews should support him because he supports Israel.

That, for Perlmutter, is the primary issue ... "Jews can live with all the domestic priorities of the Christian Right on which liberal Jews differ so radically because none of these concerns is as important as Israel." Perlmutter recognizes that evangelical fundamentalists interpret Scripture as saying all Jews eventually must accept Jesus Christ or be killed in the battle of Armageddon. But, meanwhile, he says, "We need all the friends we have to support Israel ... If the Messiah comes, on that day we'll consider our options. Meanwhile, let's praise the Lord and pass the ammunition." Irving Kristol, a leading spokesman for New York's Jewish intellectual community, also urges American Jews to forget liberalism and "join the ultra-right." Everyone is headed in that direction, he believes, adding that in this "real world" Jews are better off to back the ultra-conservatives." **Ibid**, p. 84.

19. A movement **as godless** as Zionism now has a true friend in Evangelicals, but this shows that they are both alike although the so-called Christians profess to be followers of Christ.

"Jacques Torozyner, an executive of the American sector of the World Zionist Organization, went further, stating it was natural for Zionists to embrace the Christian Right." **Ibid**, p. 85.

20. Thus as we near the close of Earth's history, militant Jewish leaders and Evangelicals have formed an alliance.

"Recognizing the importance of its alliance with the Christian fundamentalists, the Rabbinical Council appointed Rabbi Abner Wiess as its liaison to the New Christian Right ... Militant Jewish leaders and Christian dispensationalists have formed an alliance that embraces the same dogma. This dogma is not about spiritual values or living a good life so much as it is about political power and worldly possession—about one group of people physically taking sole possession of land holy to three faiths. It is a dogma centered entirely on a small political entity—Israel. Both Jewish leaders and dispensationalists make ownership of land the highest priority in their lives ..." Ibid, p. 86.

21. The Evangelicals are actually raising money to help demolish the Muslim shrine in Jerusalem.

"Douglas Krieger, an evangelical lay leader of Denver, Colorado, closely connected with Terry Reisenhoover in raising money to eradicate a mosque and build a temple in Jerusalem, early on urged Israel to work with and totally embrace evangelical fundamentalists in exchange for their support of Israel." **Ibid**, p. 85.

22. The Religious Right can be used to support Israel and to paint an acceptable image of them to the public to protect their violent militaristic seizure of Arab lands from causing a reaction negative to Israel. This is the horrible claim of these apostate Evangelicals.

"If the Israelis took the second choice and continued their militaristic aggrandizement which Krieger, as a dispensationalist urged them to do—then the Israelis and American Jews would face the danger of an outbreak of anti-Semitism. Because of Israel's military seizure of Arab lands, "a rise of anti-Semitism could possibly surge in the West." This could be prevented, however, Krieger said, through its alliance with the New Christian Right. He pointed out that Israel could use the evangelical-fundamentalists to project through their vast radio and television networks an image of Israel that Americans would like, accept and support. Moreover, Krieger said, "The Religious Right could sell the Americans on the idea that God wanted a militant, militarized Israel. And that the more militant Israel became, the more supportive and ecstatic in its support the U. S. Right would become." **Ibid**, p. 85.

23. What we have just read proves to us how the Evangelicals in a large way responsible for the behavior of Israel towards the Palestinians by psychological and economic support. Evangelicals have even urged the Israelis to flout international law. How horrible is the terrorist nature of this Spiritualistic so-called Christian religion.

"In the 1967 war, Israel, in addition to the Golan Heights, also seized military control of the Sinai peninsula, territory west of the Jordan River (the West Bank), the Gaza Strip and Arab East Jerusalem. Under international law, it is not legal to occupy land seized militarily. The international law, says the religious right, applies to all nations of the world—except Israel. Jerry Falwell tells Israeli leaders they need not abide by international law." **Ibid**, p. 90.

24. Israel even fostered the creation of a Christian organization to justify their annexation of Arab East Jerusalem, thus Evangelicals have lend their support to **Israeli crimes**, yet they call themselves "Christians".

"In 1980, the Israeli government, to offset disapproval of its illegal annexation of Arab East Jerusalem, fostered the creation of a right wing Christian organization called the International Christian Embassy. The Israeli government furnished a stately former West Jerusalem Arab residence, once the home of the Said family, whose owner's nephew is the well-known Palestinian—American scholar and author Edward Said of Columbia University. The Saids are among millions of Palestinians dispossessed of their homes and living in a Diaspora. To open the newly-created Christian Embassy, the Israelis and Christian Zionist staged ceremonies attended by leading Israeli officials and 1,000 Christians, representing 23 nations." **Ibid**, p. 91.

25. This Israeli sponsored false Christian group has now spread worldwide.

"From Jerusalem, Christian Embassy leaders have fanned out around the world, opening other Israeli supported Christian "Embassies"—with political overtones and, some have suggested, covert missions—in 37 countries throughout Europe, North America, Asia and Australia, as well as across America where there are an estimated 20 such offices." **Ibid**, pp. 91-92.

26. When Ariel Sharon, the so-called Israeli butcher and war criminal, led an attack into Lebanon, the famous evangelical **Pat Robertson** was in the fray with the Israeli army

giving them support. How can these "Christians" be of God?

"In 1982, Israel sent tanks and invaded its northern neighbor, Lebanon. Ariel Sharon led the attack. Pat Robertson rode into the fray in an Israeli jeep. In the ensuing war, Israel killed and wounded 200,000 Lebanese and Palestinians, most of them civilians. In waging the war on its neighbor, Israel, said Robertson, was doing God's will. While Robertson did not fight in the war, Jewish American citizens donned Israeli uniforms and fought alongside Israeli soldiers." **Ibid**, p. 92.

27. So much Evangelicals are caught up in Zionism which came from Kabbalistic spiritualism, that Jerry Falwell, the evangelical pastor pledged to mobilize millions of Christians support for Israel.

"In March, 1985, Jerry Falwell, speaking to a conservative Rabbinical Assembly in Miami, pledged to mobilize 70 million conservative Christians for Israel." **Ibid**, p. 92.

28. Evangelicals have now formed Christian Zionism, a copy of the Jewish organization that only could have existed because the Jews rejected Jesus and had become defiant in their rebellion; yet Evangelicals claims that they are God's Church.

"In August, 1985, I attended the first of the Christian Zionist Congresses, which were instigated by Israel and Christian dispensationalists. It was held in Basel, Switzerland, in the same hall where 88 years earlier Theodor Herzl, a secular Jew and Austrian journalist, in an appeal to all Jews to live exclusively among Jews, had staged the first Jewish Zionist Congress. I [the author] was one of 589 persons from 27 countries attending the three-day conference. We met in sessions lasting 12 hours a day. We listened to top Israelis as well as Christian leaders. Out of a total of 36 hours we were in session, I estimated that delegates spent more than 99 percent of the time on politics. The conference had nothing to do with Christ, and was all about how Israel could support the political agenda of the dispensationalists—and they, in turn, could support the political agenda of the Israelis." **Ibid**, pp. 92-93.

29. The Israeli Prime Minister, Netanyahu, used Evangelicals to pledge to keep America supporting Israel.

"In 1996, Netanyahu, newly elected Israeli prime minister, convened the Israel Christian Advocacy Council. He invited 17 evangelical and fundamentalist leaders to visit Israel, including Don Argue, president of the National Association of Evangelicals; Brandt Gustavson, president of the National Religious Broadcasters; and Donald Wildmon, president of the American Family Association. These leaders, representing several million Christians signed a pledge expressing the hope that America will never, never desert Israel." **Ibid**, pp. 93-94.

30. Evangelicals have also retarded the progress of Israeli Palestinian talks that would see Israel return Palestinian lands to them, thus the Palestinians are in their despair partly because of Evangelicals.

"January, 1998: Falwell helped arrange a meeting between Israeli Prime Minister Netanyahu and Christian supporters of Israel, including Southern Baptist Convention leaders Morris Chapman and Richard Land as well as John Hagee of San Antonio. The Christians pledged to mobilize their communities against the Clinton administration's pressure on Israel to relinquish Palestinian lands. Falwell told Netanyahu: 'There are 200,000 evangelical pastors in America and we're asking them all through e-mail, faxes, letters, telephone, to go into their pulpits and use their influence in support of the state of Israel and the prime minister." **Ibid**, p. 94.

31. Evangelicals raised money to help Israel resettle Soviet Jews and also became a breaker of international law.

"1998: John Hagee, dispensationalist pastor in San Antonio, raised \$1 million for Israel, to help resettle Soviet Jews in Palestinian lands. Asked if he realized that his plan went against international law, Hagee said, 'I am a Bible scholar and a theologian and from my perspective, the law of God transcends the law of the United States government and the U. S. State Departments." **Ibid**, pp. 95-96.

32. Evangelicals have even praised the Israelis for canceling its Wye Peace accords with the Palestinians, thus encouraging them to perpetuate the genocidal Middle Eastern problem. Evangelicals share largely in the guilt of the protracted Middle Eastern stalemate and the horrific deaths it has caused on both sides, including the Muslims hit back on America.

"1998: Israel canceled its obligations to live up to the Wye Peace accords with the Palestinians. Christian Coalition leaders praised Israel for being tough, for rejecting peace." **Ibid**, p. 96.

33. Evangelicals are even being subverted into Judaism by Jewish Zionist groups formed to give support to Israel.

"No Israeli prime minister since Menachem Begin would think of making a trip to the United States without checking in with leaders of the New Christian Right in both public and private meetings ... The real story in the last 20 years is the founding of scores of small, grassroots, pro-Israel organizations that rarely get into the headlines. They exist to mobilize their local evangelical community to support Israel ... The Restoration Foundation of Atlanta puts on seminars, colloquia, and retreats to promote "the restoration of all believers to their rightful heritage in the Judaism of the first century church" and love for Israel and its people. The Arkansas Institute of Holy Land Studies in Sherwood Arkansas, advertises itself as a "specialty college" and offers unaccredited bachelor's and master's degrees in "Middle East History" ... Hebraic Heritage Ministries of Houston wants Christians to worship on Saturdays and observe the Jewish festivals ..." Ibid, p. 97.

34. Evangelical are even responsible for the Israelis building Jewish settlements on Palestinian lands by their support for Israel in their unjust and destructively oppressive actions.

"In 1995 Ted Beckett of Colorado organized the Christian Friends for Israeli Communities to provide "solidarity, comfort and aid" to Jewish settlements in the West Bank and Gaza by linking them with evangelical congregations in the United States. By 1998, there were 35 congregations involved, all of them expected to promote awareness of Israel in their communities". **Ibid**, p. 97.

35. Israel have sought Evangelicals for support to keep the lands they look by force from the Arabs; thus with such great support coming from these Evangelicals, surely these so-called Christians are guilty for encouraging the Israelis of depriving the Palestinians of their homeland and the oppressive brutality and murder that resulted.

"Israel turned to the marriage of convenience with dispensationalists after it began to lose support of some liberal American Jews, who were pressuring the Jewish state to relinquish militarily-occupied Arab lands in exchange for peace agreements with its neighbors, including the Palestinians. Israel, not wanting to vacate the lands, sought support in America's corridors of power from religio-politicians such as Jerry Falwell and other dispensationalists" **Ibid**, p. 99.

36. Even the largest so-called Protestant body in the U. S. A., the Southern Baptist Convention supported Israel's evil behavior.

"In 1998, all top SBC officials eagerly sought meetings with Israeli Prime Minister Netanyahu, pledging their support for his agenda and receiving his support for theirs." **Ibid**, p. 109.

37. Imagine the U. S. government hiring evangelical Hal Lindsey as an expert on Middle Eastern affairs. This man is incredibly biased against Arabs, and views everything in the light of Israel and his false prophecies.

"White House Seminars' became a regular feature of Reagan's administration bringing Lindsay into direct personal contact with national and Congressional leaders. Lindsey subsequently became a consultant on Middle Eastern affairs not only to the Pentagon but also to the Israeli Government." Stephen R. Sizer, **Hal Lindsey: The Father of Apocalyptic Christian Zionism**, p. 7.

38. Evangelical's support or Israel is based upon a misinterpretation of certain passages of scriptures that they believe. These positions are extremely wrong. Read Hal Lindsey:

"However, God made unconditional promises of eternal blessings to the Jewish patriarchs and will someday restore the Jews to a position of special favor with Himself ... God has promised never to abandon His chosen people, no matter how despicably they treat Him ... The divine hand of protection of the Jews during their recent Six-Day War was just a token of that protective care" Hal Lindsey, **There's A New World Coming, A Prophetic Odyssey**, p. 115.

"God clearly reveals that the tree into which we Gentiles have been grafted contrary to

nature is still the Jew's own olive tree. The simple meaning of this is that the covenants are still valid to the physical race of Israel. Their fulfillment only awaits that predicted time when God will bring them back to faith again." Hal Lindsey, **The Road to Holocaust**, p. 197.

"Unless one goes off into allegorical la-la land, these prophecies literally demand a National restoration of Israel as a distinct and unique believing Nation in the future kingdom." Hal Lindsey, **The Road to Holocaust**, p. 208.

- 39. The Evangelicals guilt in the Middle Eastern Crisis is due to the fact that they refuse to understand the following points:
 - a. The Jews of flesh are not God's people, those who have the faith of Abraham they are the Children of God. (Galatians 3:7-9, 16, 26-29).
 - b. The children of the flesh are not the seed of Abraham thus heirs of the promises, the children of the promise the church, made up of Jews and Gentiles are counted for the seed of Abraham, thus are the people of God. (Romans 9:8, 24; Galatians 4:28).
 - c. The old covenant distinction between Jews and Gentiles was abolished by the death of Jesus Christ. (Ephesians 2:13-16).
 - d. The death of Christ on the cross blotted out the old covenant ceremonial laws forever. (Colossians 2:14, 16, 17).
 - e. Christ abolished the old covenant, never more to be in force, the new covenant is now existing. (Hebrews 8:8-12).
 - f. The animal sacrifices were just a shadow, just symbols of Jesus Christ and His death, they have been abolished with the coming of the Messiah, Jesus; to reinstate them is to deny that Jesus was the Messiah, as the Jews are doing today hence the reason why they want to restore the animal sacrifices. (Hebrews 10:1-9).
 - g. The heavenly temple is in function, thus there is no need for an earthly one to be built. (Romans 8:1-7).
 - h. Since Jesus the Messiah is the real high priest, the reinstitution of the priestly function today is invalid, because it denies the messiahship and eternal priesthood of Jesus. (Hebrews 7:11-28).
 - i. Jesus only said that the Jewish temple will be destroyed, but He never said it would be rebuilt. (Matthew 24:1-2).
 - j. The Jewish rejection of Christ led to the destruction of the temple, and it is to remain so to the final end. (Daniel 9:26, 27).

- k. The Jewish rejection of Jesus as the Christ led to their loss of the land, the destruction of the temple and the Jews being exiled among the nations; now, to restore these things is to rebel against the retribution of their own evil. How then can God's church support Israel? (Luke 21:20-24; Matthew 23:31-39).
- 1. The Jews are rejected of God as a nation because they are under a curse. (1 Thessalonians 2:14-16).
- 40. In the conclusion, the Evangelical's support for Israel shows that they are not of God, but is a satanically inspired religion with false doctrines of devils denying the power of God but having a form of godliness. (1 Timothy 4:1; 2 Timothy 3:1, 5; 2 Corinthians 11:13-15).
