The Science of Overcoming Sin

- 1. Sin <u>must</u> be overcome. (PFC, 53 -54)
- 2. We <u>must resist</u> unto blood. (Jam 4:7; Heb 12:3, 4)
- 3. What is sin? Transgression of God's Law (1Jn 3:4)
 - a. The Law is Righteousness (Ps 119:172).
 - b. Unrighteousness is sin (1Jn 5:17)
 - c. Sin being opposite to Righteousness which is the Law, is the opposite of the Law or breaking the law (Rom 6:16, 18, 20; Dan 4:27).
- 4. We transgress in thoughts (Gen 6:5; Ps 94:11; Pro 15:26; Isa 55:7).
- 5. We transgress in works (Ps 141:4; Isa 59:6 Jn 7:7; Col 1:21).
- 6. Sin is sin <u>against</u> God (Ps 51:4; Isa 42:24; Jer 3:25; Jer 14:7, 20; Jer 8:14; Jer 33:8; Hos 4:7; Mic 7:9; Lk 15:18, 21).
- 7. When we sin we profane God's glory. (Rom 1:23).
- 8. Sin, transgression of God's law, is also coming short of glorifying God. (Rom 3:23).
- 9. How is this so? How can this be proven?
 - a. The Law is spiritual (Rom 7:14).
 - b. The Law is a transcript of God's nature (Rom 7:12) Holy (Lev 11:44; Lev 19:2); Just (Deu 32:14; Isa 45:21); Good (Matt 19:17; Ps 119:68).
 - c. To therefore have the spiritual law in us, is to have God's Nature Love dwelling in us (Rom 13:10; 1Jn 4:7, 8, 15, 16).
 - d. God's Nature or Love (dwelling in us), is God's Glory in us (Jam 2:1; Jn 1:14; 1Jn 4:7, 8).
 - e. To sin against God (which is breaking the Law), is to take the Glory of God His Nature (or name), and to give it to another (Isa 42:8; Isa 48:11).
 - f. Example of doing this:

Spiritual Law, Love, God's Glory

Giving God's Glory to Another

i. God is God Money is God

ii God is Glory Money is Glory

iii God is Will Money is Will

iv God is Creator Money is Creator

v God is Life Money is Life

vi God is Saviour Money is Saviour

vii God is Eternal Money is Eternal

viii God is Grace Money is Grace

ix God is Truth Money is Truth

x God is Righteousness Money is Righteousness

- g. Examples of glorifying money, or giving the glory of god to money. Boomer Bible, p. 211,213,215,220,223-224.
- 10. The Glory of God is given to another by taking error as truth, believing it and following it, thus it makes us sin. Why? Because error exalts creation as God with the attributes of God in place of God. (Isa 32:6; Jam 5:20; 2Pet 3:17, 18; 1Jn 4:6).
- 11. How then do we overcome sin? How then are we made right, or made to function properly according to God's Will? The Gospel of Christ is the only answer (Rom 1:16, 17).
- 12. The Gospel is Truth (Gal 2:5, 14; Eph 1:13; Col 1:5).
- 13. The Gospel has certain principles in it that makes it achieves giving us (I) righteous thoughts (ii) good works and also (iii) glorifying God, or having God's glory in us.
- 14. The truth of the Gospel is Faith, the revealed Truths of Christ (Heb 11:1; 1Tim 4:6; Rom 10:8).
- 15. Some impression principles in the Gospel that accomplishes our salvation are: (see Tit 2:11-15; Tit 3:4-7; 2Cor 4:3-7; 10, 11).
 - a. It glorifies or exalts God as the highest.
 - b. I has the essence of self-denial or rejection of wrong

- c. It emphasizes submission to God, the highest for life
- d. It is a knowledge so that one can think about it.
- e. It outlines the works of the Law as need to be practised.
- 16. Thus to be righteous, when we believe, God must by His grace impute Faith unto us for Righteousness (Mk 1:14, 15).
 - a. Righteousness by Grace (God's attitude) (Rom 3:2; Rom 4:16).
 - b. Righteousness by Faith (Instrument) (Heb 11:7; Rom 4:9).
 - c. Righteousness by Imputation (God's method) (Rom 4:3, 6, 11).
- 17. When we are justified we get the Righteousness of God (God's Nature Jer 23:5, 6) place within us, thus this is the Glory of God in us. (Rom 3:21, 22; Isa 51:7, 8; Eph 3:16-19).
- 18. Through the Faith of the Gospel, its Righteousness (God's Glory) dwells in us (Rom 1:16, 17; 1Tim 3:9; 2Tim 1:5; Rom 13:22).
- 19. We must then consciously think the Gospel truths which is having holy thoughts (Pro 12:5; Phil 4:8).
- 20. We must then consciously do the works of the law because of Faith. This is having good works (Rom 3:28, 31; Phil 4:9).
- 21. The truth or faith of the Gospel which we think, because of its principles of impression, it places and keeps the glory of God in us and therefore makes us glorify God (Jn 7:18; 2Cor 4:6, 7, 15; Hab 2:14; Mal 1:15; Isa 42:12. Rom 4:20).
