
The Two Enemies Of God And Man:



- 1. <u>Rights</u> and <u>Freedoms</u> were created by <u>God</u>. When man was created an <u>intelligent being</u> with certain <u>abilities</u>, he was created with <u>Rights and Freedoms</u>. Gen. 1:27-29; Gen. 2:7, 15-17.
- 2. Our <u>duty</u> to each other that we must not <u>owe</u> to each other; is to <u>respect</u> the Rights and Freedoms of each other. Eccl. 12:13; Rom. 13:8-13.
- 3. We have three fundamental Rights. They are:
 - i. The Right to Religious Liberty.
 - ii. The Right to Life.
 - iii. The Right to Private Property.
- 4. We also have eight fundamental freedoms. They are:
 - i. Freedom of Thought.
 - ii. Freedom of Belief.
 - iii. Freedom of Choice.
 - iv. Freedom of Conscience.
 - v. Freedom of Opinion.
 - vi. Freedom of Speech.
 - vii. Freedom of Expression.
 - viii. Freedom of Movement.
- 5. We use our <u>Freedoms</u> to <u>fulfil</u> and <u>enjoy</u> our <u>Rights</u>. This is how God made it. Acts 4:1-3, 15-21; Acts 5:17-29.
- 6. We are told of two powers that are against <u>man</u> and <u>God</u> on the earth. They are the following.
 - a. King of the North (Papacy). Dan. 11:15, 16, 20, 21, 40.


- b. The King of the South (Illuminism). (Dan. 11:8, 9, Ex. 5:2).
- 7. These two powers are against men's Rights and Freedoms.
 - a. The <u>Papacy</u> is against man's Rights and Freedoms. Rev. 13:1-3, 7, 8; Rev. 17:5, 6.
 - b. <u>Illuminism</u> is against man's Rights and Freedoms. Rev. 11:7, 8, 13.

- 9. The Papacy is against God. Dan. 11:36, 37; 2 Thess. 2:3, 4.
- 10. The illuminati is against God. Rev. 17:11-14.
- 11. <u>Man</u> was created by God with the <u>purpose</u> to <u>exalt</u> God to be <u>God alone</u>. Isa. 43:10-12; Isa. 44:6-8.
- 12. Attacking <u>God in man</u> would mean attacking the <u>Rights and Freedoms of man</u>. Dan. 6:4-13.



13. Hostility to <u>God</u> is manifested as hostility to man's Rights and Freedoms. Dan. 3:12-21.



14. God came in a temple of human flesh. Rom. 8:3; Jn. 1:14.

- 15. Lucifer's attacks on the <u>man</u> Christ Jesus was to get Him to declare that he was God with God; this was an attack <u>against God</u>. Being <u>anti-God</u> meant being <u>anti-man</u>. (Mk. 1:13; Lu. 4:5-8).
 - a. Lucifer attacked man's <u>Private Property Rights</u> to deny God's <u>God-aloneness</u>. Matt. 4:3, 4.
 - b. Lucifer attacked man's <u>Right to Life</u> to deny God's God-aloneness. Matt. 4:5-7.
 - c. Lucifer attacked man's <u>Religious Liberty Right</u> to be declared God with God, thus attacking God's God-aloneness. Matt. 4:8-10.

- 16. Here are to openly expressed statements of the King of the South, <u>Illuminism</u> to the Rights and Freedoms of man. We shall look at this in the teachings of Communism a form of Illuminism.
 - "We must combat religion that is the ABC of all materialism, and consequently of Marxism. But Marxism is not a materialism which has stopped at the ABC. Marxism goes further. It says: We must know how to combat religion, and in order to do so we must explain the source of faith and religion among the masses in a materialist way. The combating of religion cannot be confined to abstract ideological preaching, and it must not be reduced to such preaching. It must be linked up with the concrete practice of the class movement, which aims at eliminating the social roots of religion." V. I. Lenin, On Religion, pg. 21.

 - 3. Abolition of private property.
 - 4. Abolition of patriotism.
 - 5. Abolition of family.

- 18. Thus the facts are that the Global conspiracy against <u>YHWH and Christ</u> by the rulers of the nations, leads them to attempt to sever the <u>cords</u> that connect man to God, thus attacking the Rights and Freedoms of man to do so. Ps. 2:1-3.
- 19. <u>One pastor</u> of a particular church in the city of Rome that became a <u>universal pastor</u>, a substitute of God and Christ on the earth, called the Vicar of Christ, is the other enemy of God and man. Concerning him we are told.
 - "The Roman Pontiff, head of the college of bishops, enjoys the infallibility in virtue of his office, when, as supreme pastor and teacher of all the faithful who confirms his brethren in the faith he proclaims in an absolute decision a doctrine pertaining to faith

or morals. For that reason his definitions are rightly said to be irreformable..." <u>Vatican</u> <u>Council II</u>, pg. 380.

- 20. The anti-Rights and Freedoms nature of the <u>papal office</u>, of a God with God, is clearly seen in the following statements.
 - "If Catholics ever gain a sufficient numerical majority in this country, religious freedom is at an end. So our enemies say, so we believe." <u>The Shepherd of the Vally</u>, official journal of the Bishop of St. Louis, Nov. 23, 1851.
 - "No man has a right to choose his religion." <u>New York Freedom</u>, official journal of Bishop Hughes, Jan, 26, 1852.
 - "The church... does not, and cannot accept, or in any degree favour, liberty in the Protestant sense of liberty." <u>Catholic World</u>, April, 1870.
 - "Protestantism has not, and never can have, any right where Catholicity has triumphed." **Catholic Review, June, 1875.**
 - "Religious liberty is merely endured until the opposite can be carried into effect without peril to the Catholic Church." **Rt. Rev. O'Connor, Bishop of Pittsburgh.**
 - "You ask if the Pope were lord over this land and you were in a minority, what he would do to you? That, we say, would entirely depend on circumstances. If it would benefit the cause of Catholicism, he would tolerate you: if expedient, he would imprison, banish you, probably he might even hang you. But be assured of one thing, he would never tolerate

you for the sake of your glorious principles of Civil and religious liberty." <u>Rambler</u>, one of the most prominent Catholic papers of England, Sept., 1851.
